Ride For The Living is a fitness experience commemorating the Holocaust and honoring the rebirth of the Jewish community in Krakow, Poland. RFTL combines Holocaust education with a memorable 60-mile bike ride from the gates of Auschwitz-Birkenau to JCC Krakow. This year's RFTL has been transformed into the Global Challenge where participants will bike, run, or walk 60 miles virtually. On June 27 th , JCC Krakow Executive Director Jonathan Ornstein and representatives of the JCC will symbolically cycle from Auschwitz to JCC Krakow in honor of over 2,800 participants taking part in the program.
